Facing the Russian invasion, coherence and coordination between authorities, the Armed Forces of Ukraine, volunteer organizations, as well as the help of Ukraine's partners abroad are critical to defeat the enemy and restore the country.

Our joint project with the Ministry of Health of Ukraine and the Kyiv Regional Military Administration to restore the destroyed Makariv outpatient clinic is an example of such coordination. In June, we started its practical implementation: we hired a contractor and launched the preparatory stage of construction.

Among the international programs, we want to remind you of the Mint For Ukraine project, the largest collection of NFT art in history: 1 million art pieces symbolising the Ukrainian spirit. Information about this event is spreading around the world.

Moreover, together with our Austrian partners, Christine König Gallery and Dorotheum, we held an auction of modern Ukrainian art. The collected funds were directed to housing for 40 Ukrainian children and their families.

We also continue our joint humanitarian project with Data And Aid Tech (D.A.T.A.) initiative. Volunteers involved in IT technologies continue a fundraiser to buy first-aid kits. We want to thank D.A.T.A. for the saved lives of Ukrainians!

And, of course, we worked on the most important track for Ukrainian society nowadays: supporting the Armed Forces of Ukraine fighting for our victory.

The KSE team thanks everyone who joined the fundraiser.

Slava Ukraini! Glory to Ukraine!




