This month, we found out that KSE has collected UAH 1 billion in donations since the start of the Russian full-scale invasion. Forbes Ukraine noticed that fact and included KSE Foundation in the updated ranking of the most effective state, non-state funds and public organizations that raise funds to support Ukrainians and the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

Our team holds the 4th place among the non-state funds of Ukraine and shares the 9th place with the United Help Ukraine (USA) in the global ranking.

In July, KSE continued to raise funds for the restoration of the outpatient clinic in the city of Makariv, Kyiv region. Due to the active combat in the area, this health care center has suffered significant damage. Our new partner UKRGASBANK, together with the international payment system Visa, has joined the restoration of the local medical infrastructure.

As part of this project, we collaborate with the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, the Kyiv Regional Military Administration, and the Municipal Non-Commercial Enterprise “Makariv Center for Primary Health Care”. The collected funds have already allowed the preparatory works. The ultimate goal of the project is to collect UAH 20 million to restore the health care center for the residents of Makariv.

We continue to work in humanitarian areas in order to provide charitable assistance to people in need.






