The reconstruction of the Makariv outpatient clinic, the Safe Education program, the First Lady's project to promote Ukrainian books abroad, the development of the Defense Innovation defense ecosystem - these are the areas in which our Foundation invested in October.

Reconstruction of Makariv outpatient clinic is a symbolic project for us. The construction equator has been crossed, the building of the future outpatient clinic is almost 60% complete. KSE and partners are confident that the institution will be able to receive patients in early 2023!

There are the first results of the Safe Education project: Chytyrbotskyi lyceum in the Khmelnytskyi region received a shelter built according to modern standards. More than a hundred children have returned to classes and, unfortunately, have already used the renovated shelter. Currently, we are repairing five schools, and we are considering applications from 73 more educational institutions.

Currently, millions of Ukrainians, including children, are abroad in a foreign cultural space. Our common goal is to give them a book in their native language. This is the meaning of the project of First Lady Olena Zelenska - "Ukrainian Bookshelf", to which the KSE Foundation has joined. Presentations of the program have already taken place in Warsaw and Frankfurt am

taken place in Warsaw and Frankfurt am Main. Soon Ukrainian books will appear in the leading libraries of Europe!




