In December, KSE Foundation received an award from the President of Ukraine, continued to care about the safety of schoolchildren within the framework of the Safe Education project, raised funds for the points of invincibility, and supported talented youth.

On December 5, International Volunteer Day, the Kyiv School of Economics Foundation became one of the first charitable organizations to receive a new award from Volodymyr Zelenskyy - the Golden Heart.

We are proud that our activities were recognized, it motivates our team to work even more fruitfully in 2023! 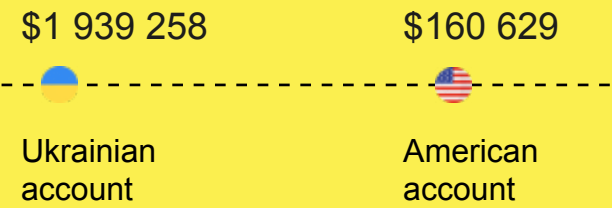
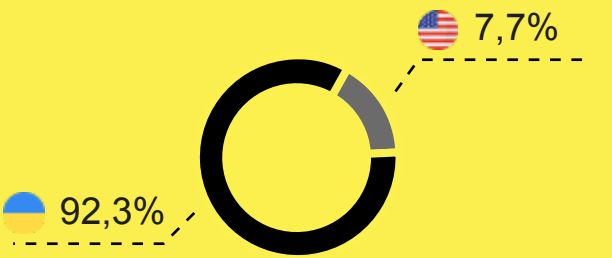
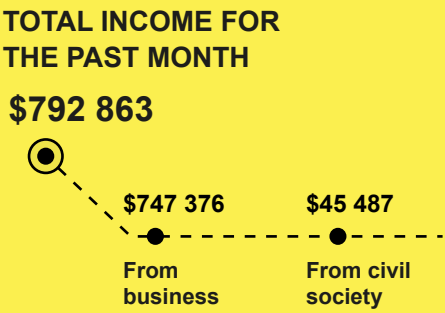
Our Foundation continues to work on the Safe Education campaign. 2605 pupils have already been able to study offline thanks to the shelters equipped in their schools.

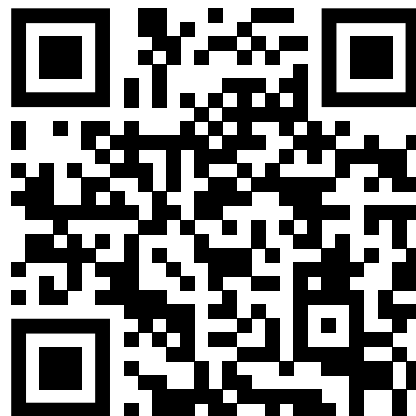

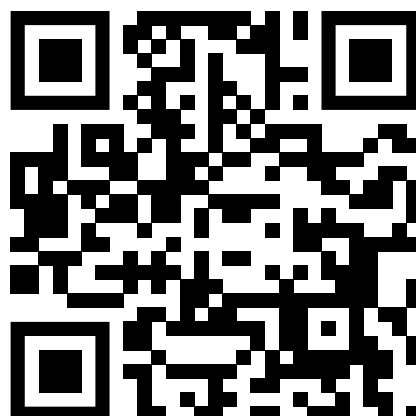
