### **March: building victory together!**

**Charitable fund KSE Foundation continues to work actively during the full-scale aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine. Without the support of each of you on your own and funds, without the help of benefactors and volunteers, without cooperation with our partners would not be able to help the Army on a daily basis and take care of adults and young Ukrainians.**

We have a lot of good news for March that I want to tell you about:

- Another 13 participants joined the «Talents for Ukraine» program. Fifty talented artists and creative people have already received grants to develop their ideas and implement innovations! Our team is sincerely happy with the new faces who are already developing Ukraine.
- The dispensary in Makarov, destroyed by the Russians, made it impossible to provide medical assistance to thousands of residents of the community. KSE Foundation undertook the restoration of the medical facility as the first non-state charity fund involved by the authorities in the restoration of infrastructure. Thanks to our benefactors, the dispensary will soon receive its first patients!
- The "Safe Education" initiative is gaining momentum. 21 schools received reliable shelter - thanks to this, more than 7 thousand students were able to return to offline learning! We do not stop in our efforts to provide safe and quality education to future generations of Ukrainians during air alarms.
- Thanks to the funds of an international benefactor, we handed over hundreds of DJI Mavic 3 quadcopters and the Mavic 3 Fly More Combo. In addition to the transfer of equipment for the needs of various divisions, special attention is now being paid to the training and preparation of specialists. More trained staff - it's lives saved and tasks accomplished.

Our work continues. A lot has already been done but we are not stopping, because there are still many projects ahead that need to be implemented. And none of them, past and future, is impossible without you. Thank you for every contribution, information and moral support. Thank you for always being there!

We are sure that together we will achieve success and achieve our common victory.

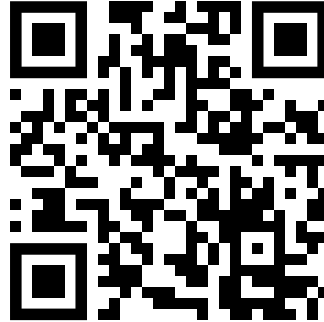

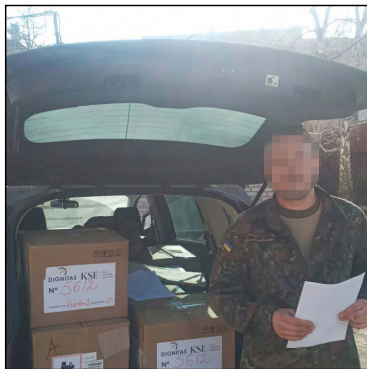
