APRIL: STEP BY STEP, TOGETHER WE ARE REBUILDING UKRAINE

Dear friends and partners!

Thanks to you, the charitable fund KSE Foundation continues to work every day for our common victory. But your systemic trust has taught us that while working for victory, we must also rebuild Ukraine now.

We are pleased to present to you one of our greatest achievements in the restoration of the infrastructure destroyed by Russia: in April, the KSE Foundation, together with partners - the Ministry of Health, the Kyiv Regional Military Administration, the Makariv community, and our benefactors - presented the rebuilt Makariv medical clinic in the Kyiv region! The dispensary, which was destroyed a year ago by a direct missile hit, is today ready to receive more than 19,000 patients.

BEFOR

The outpatient clinic in the village of Makariv, Kyiv region, was completely destroyed by a direct Russian missile strike on March 28, 2022.



AFTER

Now the dispensary has been completely restored by the KSE Foundation, the first non-governmental charitable foundation that the government involved in the restoration of the medical infrastructure.



In the last month, we made a significant step towards our common victory, and the reconstruction of the medical facility is only one of them.

In April we:

- We continued to invest in training the military to use technologies of war: from effective control of drones to countering electronic warfare. Hundreds more soldiers were trained.
- Dozens of DJI Mavic 3 drones were sent to the front line.
- Systematic work to protect lives was continued: transferred to the front were defensive ammunition, medical supplies, optical devices, etc.
- Crossed the mark of 7,000 children who were able to return to safe offline studying thanks to KSE Foundation's school shelters.
- KSE Prompt Design Challenge, the first artificial intelligence competition among high school students in Ukraine, was held! The future of Ukraine is based on its smart, talented, motivated children. Our goal is to support their endeavors and give impetus to their development. Four winning teams received certificates for the purchase of Apple equipment.
- Invested in talented people - provided grants for self-development to an architect of modular housing for evacuated Ukrainians, a biophysicist, a developer of an autonomous mine detector, and many others.

The enemy continues to destroy critical infrastructure and attack civilian targets. But with your help, we are building a new Ukraine on these ruins right now.

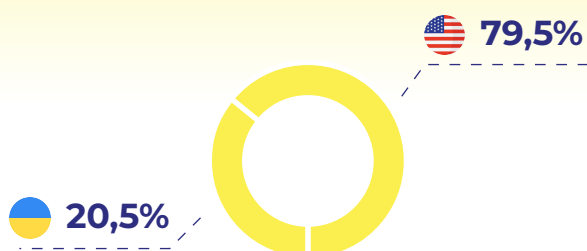

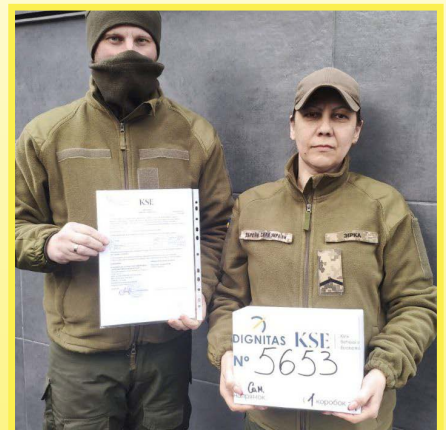
