PROTECT THE FAMILIES OF THOSE WHO PROTECT US

Dear friends, partners, benefactors

Every day of war brings grief and destruction, and we sincerely thank you – everyone who contributes from a few UAH to tens of millions – for reducing the number of these painful days and making victory closer.

In the second year of the war, our goal to protect the families of those who protect us remains unchanged. Therefore, arranging school shelters is one of the most important projects. This month, for World Vyshyvanka Day, students from rural schools gave us a tour of the basements of their educational institutions – dark, damp, with fungus on the walls and a layer of sand instead of a floor. Just like school "shelters" before their renovation.

One of these schools is the Brusyliv Art School. Its students witnessed many tragic events, because

the Zhytomyr highway is 12 kilometers away. "The highway of death", as people began to call it. It was there in March 2022 that heavy battles were fought, many civilians died.

The excursions became the basis for a photo-documentary exhibition that personifies Ukrainian childhood during the war. This childhood is fragile and vulnerable. We have to protect him in spite of everything.



Thanks to your support, the KSE Foundation can do the most important thing – protect people. In May we:

- Crossed the line of 1,500 reconnaissance drones, which were transferred to the front line
- We were happy to congratulate thousands of schoolchildren who could celebrate this day in their native schools with the holiday of the last bell. Availability of reliable shelter is a basic requirement for resuming offline lessons in educational institutions. Together with you, we have already returned 10,000 schoolers and preschoolers.
- We set ourselves an ambitious goal: to give another 10,000 children the opportunity to start the next academic year within the walls of schools, with high-quality offline education, practical classes, friends and teachers. To this end, work has already begun on arranging shelters in dozens of kindergartens and schools. We are systematically moving towards the mark of 300 arranged shelters.
- We helped wounded soldiers dozens of soldiers were able to recover faster thanks to the contribution of FUIB, with which we were able to purchase a vacuum apparatus for rapid wound healing.
- We continued to invest in talented Ukrainians. This month, we awarded self-development grants of \$5,000 to an oncology surgeon, a neurobiologist, a Ukrainian history teacher who defended Mariupol as part of the Azov Regiment and returned from Russian captivity, and many others. These people are developing Ukraine, advancing science and introducing innovations, and thanks to you, they received the necessary support to realize their dreams.
- We also taught military technologies of war, held workshops on the use of artificial intelligence for schoolchildren, and handed over hundreds of units of protective ammunition, optical devices, etc. to the front line.

Together, we bring victory closer every day.
