AUGUST: SAVE THE FUTURE THROUGH EDUCATION

Dear partners and benefactors,

Like all of last year, our team spent August with the goal of returning as many Ukrainian schoolchildren as possible to high-quality offline education, and children to kindergartens. Thanks to your support, 35 shelters were completely ready by the end of August, 7 more are in the final stages of repair and will be ready for operation in September.

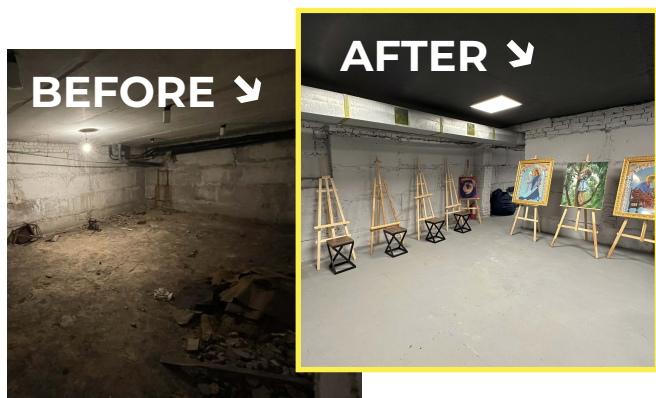
According to these numbers, 13,000 children will finally see their classmates, return to studying practical lessons, and visit their favorite clubs again. Some of them will be doing this for the first time – first due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and then due to the start of full-scale hostilities, many elementary school students have not had lessons outside of ZOOM classes. It is your contribution that will allow them to go to the school board for the first time and talk to each other during breaks. After all, the availability of shelter at school is a basic condition for the resumption of intramural classes.

It is important for us not only to give children back access to quality offline education, but also to give their parents the opportunity to return to work and self-development. For many families, distance studying became the reason for one of the parents to refuse to work – because the children needed supervision at home.

We are grateful for every contribution to protect the future of Ukraine. We are also proud to announce that this month the soloist of the Ukrainian electro-folk band «ONUKA» Nata Zhyzhchenko became the ambassador of the project «ZAKHYSTOK: Safe Education». Together, we started the repair of the shelter for school children of Koriukivskyi Lyceum №2 in the Chernihiv region.

However, in August, studies will begin not only for schoolchildren – more than 500 new students of the Kyiv School of Economics will begin studies at bachelor's and master's degrees. Among them: military personnel, war veterans, children of fallen soldiers, entrants who evacuated from temporarily occupied territories, talented Ukrainians – for each of these categories, the KSE Foundation provided educational scholarships that will cover all years of study, as well as paid 50% of the cost of living in co-living quarters .

Thanks to your support, they will receive an education for the development and reconstruction of Ukraine at one of the best universities in Eastern Europe. We continue collecting educational scholarships for talented and intelligent Ukrainians, defenders who return from the front line and need reintegration.

Another very important project for our team today is joint support with the UKRAINIAN DEFENSE DEVELOPMENT CHARITY FUND for the initiative of students of the Kyiv School of Economics. The «Donate to Evacuate» initiative for the purchase of evacuation helicopters at the request of The Main Directorate of Intelligence of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine was launched by KSE students in July in response to the urgent need to speed up evacuation in difficult areas of the front line.

And already in August, we state not only the success of this initiative, but also the overachievement of the initial goal. Instead of the two medical evacuation helicopters that the students planned to purchase, their courage and ambition will allow at least four MI-2 AM-1 medevacs to be sent to the front line. You can still join: the name of everyone who joins the initiative and makes a contribution of \$100 or more will be turned into a camouflage pattern by the famous Ukrainian calligrapher Lopukhina sisters and applied to the helicopter.



Also in August we:

- We continued to invest in talented Ukrainians – as part of the «Talents for Ukraine» grant program, this month we have supported lots of incredible people, including Anastasiia Tykha, whose photo, taken during the evacuation of animals from Irpin, was seen by the whole world. And also Olesia Ostrovska-Liuta, curator of the «Art Arsenal» museum, Bohdan Lohvynenko, founder of social and cultural media «Ukraïner», mathematician Olena Karlova, and others.
- Together with partners from Dignitas Fund, we continued to provide brigades on the front lines with DJI Mavic 3 reconnaissance drones.
- Makariv dispensary in Kyiv region, which is thanks to our benefactors managed to rebuild from scratch, provided medical assistance to thousands of patients.
- Continued systematic work to improve the skills of the military personnel in the management of reconnaissance unmanned aerial vehicles in partnership with the «Drone Army» project from the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of Digital, the Armed Forces of Ukraine, the State Special Communications and UNITED24. And also invested in training in military technologies of war, which is implemented by our partner Victory Drones.
- Celebrated the Independence Day of Ukraine at an evening of gratitude and unity, where outstanding Georgian singer Nino Katamadze made a gift to Ukraine with her performance.
- Together with the students of the Kyiv School of Economics, cleared 150 square meters of the basement in the Hruzhchanska Gymnasium in the Kyiv region. Now this basement is ready for the start of repair work – thanks to the contribution of Ukrposhta, we will provide shelter here for 85 schoolchildren and 26 kindergarten students.

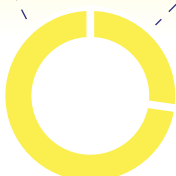

Donate To Evacuate is an initiative of students of the Kyiv School of Economics to rescue wounded soldiers on the battlefield. With the support of the UKRAINIAN DEFENSE DEVELOPMENT CHARITY FUND and the KSE Foundation, the students are raising funds for medical helicopters for the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine and intelligence support.

A medical evacuation helicopter is the fastest and irreplaceable means of transport on the battlefield. MEDEVAC MI-2 AM-1 can transport seriously injured people for a distance of 600 km at a speed of up to 200 km/h. The helicopter is equipped with everything necessary for safe evacuation and providing medical assistance during transportation: on board a ventilator, a device for monitoring the work of the heart and other medical devices.

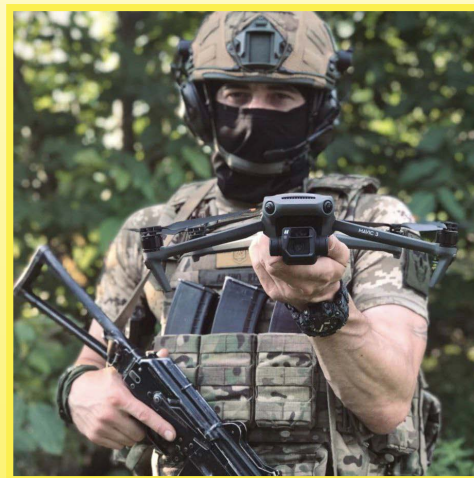
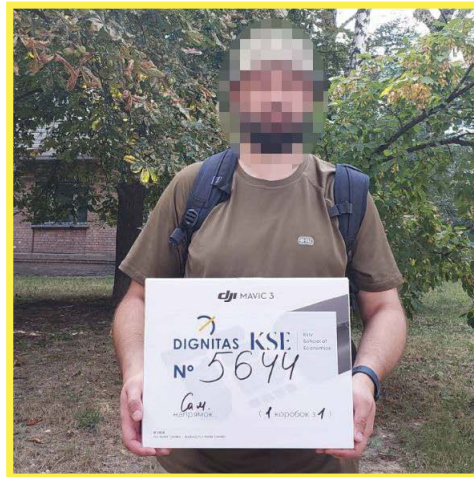
