The Kyiv School of Economics Charity Foundation has undertaken a crucial mission – to ensure that talented youth stay in Ukraine and receive a quality European-style education. Thanks to your support, in October, we continued our scholarship program, providing opportunities for development and achievement to over 300 students.

Among these students are individuals with outstanding academic achievements, already working on the realization of their own projects. Additionally, there are children who lost their homes due to missile strikes and occupation, as well as applicants who emigrated from Ukraine after

February 24, 2022, and have now returned home to study at KSE. We also support the children of fallen war heroes and war veterans, for whom education is a path to reintegrate into civilian life, such as veteran Oleksiy Kukoba.

Investing in the future begins with education, at all levels. Thanks to your contributions, we support thousands of schoolchildren in their pursuit to return to their desks and learn. The nationwide program "ZAKHYSTOK: Safe Education" by the KSE Foundation focuses on renovating shelters in schools and kindergartens across Ukraine. Equipped with facilities compliant with the State Emergency Service of Ukraine standards, these shelters allow educational institutions to resume in-person classes. With your help, we have already completed the renovation of 49 shelters, and work is ongoing in over 20 more, benefiting 16,000 children who could return to their schools and kindergartens due to your support.





Furthermore, this month, we continued to assist Ukrainians through the "Talents for Ukraine" grant program. This unique program in Ukraine provides an average grant of USD 5,000, offering financial support to talented individuals to focus on their initiatives and make a positive impact. We have recently announced 12 more winners of the program. This grant represents our investment in courageous individuals. Learn more about them

In October, our team organized #SmartFest at the Kyiv School of Economics campus, bringing together scientists, developers, activists, and artists from Ukraine, as well as students, alumni, and faculty of KSE. This three-day festival laid the foundation for the expansion of the KSE community.

A crucial aspect of our work remains strengthening Ukraine's defense capabilities. Targeted contributions from KSE Foundation benefactors to support defenders save lives every month. In October, we directed an additional USD 296,000 towards training drone reconnaissance pilots in dozens of training centers and invested over USD 100,000 in medical goods and services, communication tools, optical devices, generators, and necessary equipment.




